The following is the policy on absences used by Mounds High School.

A student who, for any reason other than school-sponsored activities, misses more than 9 days per semester in a class will not receive credit for that class. A request for appeal may be filed with the principal and reviewed by a committee of the principal and administration for final determination.

School sponsored activities do not count as an absence from school. However, students must comply with the ten (10) day activity absence rule. No more than ten (10) days can be missed for school activities per year. The only exceptions are state and national school sponsored competitions, interscholastic competitions or school assemblies.
